Prime Minister Kevin Rudd spoke at a packed Ryde Business Forum meeting breakfast this morning.

The PM spoke about the Federal Government's economic stimulus package, social housing and the rollout of the national broadband network.

When asked about the government's environmental policies and employment opportunities for young people he said the government's initiatives were not perfect but were a "damn sight better than the alternative which is to do nothing".

Bennelong Federal Labor MP Maxine McKew also attended the breakfast held at North Ryde RSL, which had a waitlist of more than 40 people.
